



## What you need when completing a Notice of Intended Marriage

Usually, we fill in this form together as we chat to get to know each other better, but if we are a long way apart or our planets don't align, there are other things we can do.

The Notice of Intended Marriage form must be completed and lodged **no later than one month before the wedding date.**  
And no earlier than 18 months before the wedding

Example - if wedding date is 5th of May 2022 the form must be lodged no later than the 5th of April 2022

A shortening of time can be applied for in the case of a terminal illness to bring date earlier - please call me if this is the case

To complete the form, you will need **both to provide** the following:

**Proof of identity :** **Birth Certificate** or **Passport** (or equivalent translated document to prove place & date of birth) and a drivers licence for photo ID

**Other documents:** if you have been previously married before, you will also need to provide any legal documents to prove the end of the last marriage, such as divorce papers, or a death certificate.

Only one of you can attend ? That's okay, as long as the document is signed prior to the wedding, and the original documents sighted. Also if you live interstate, you can get the Notice of Intended Marriage signed by any of the following; Commissioner for Declarations under the Statutory Declarations Act 1959, Justice of the Peace, Barrister or Solicitor, Legally qualified Medical Practitioner, or a member of the Australian Federal Police or the Police Force of a State or Territory) and it can be emailed through, then posted to me.
